MEET INFORMATION:

Check-in:

- All competitors (EXCLUDING HAMMER & WEIGHT THROWERS) must check in at the Clerk of the Course upon arrival to attain event stickers and a hand stamp (HAMMER & WEIGHT THROW COMPETITORS WILL CHECK IN & PAY AT THE HAMMER RING).
- Competitors will take their event stickers to the starting line of each scheduled race or site of the scheduled event, where heats, lane assignments, and flights will be determined upon
 the start of the event
- · Concurrent announcements will notify competitors of events in progress and upcoming.
- Hammer Throw, Triple Jump, High Jump, and Pole Vault will begin at their set times, and all other field events will contest under a tentative schedule based on the number of
 entrants.
- The hammer facility is located on the field south of the softball fields just east of the track. Access to the track will be limited to the path between the softball fields and around the southern field's eastern fence. No persons will be permitted to enter the hammer sector before and during the event.

Open Entries:

- Payment Cash ONLY on meet day at the Clerk of the Course (HAMMER & WEIGHT THROW COMPETITORS WILL PAY AT THE HAMMER RING).
- 4 ATTEMPTS for throwing events and horizontal jumps
- Opening heights in High Jump and Pole Vault to be determined at event site

MISCELLANOUS INFORMATION:

- Spectator & Athlete Entrance Entrance gates are located on the Southwest corner of the Titan Track Complex, which is located at the Northwestern corner of the Tennis Courts.
- Concessions will be available (CASH ONLY)
- Warm-up fields will be located on the Intramural Fields south of the track. The Southeast Gate of the track will be open and available for Warm-ups and Restroom access only.
- Spikes 1/4" PYRAMID SPIKES ONLY for all events
- False Starts: USATF or IAAF rules will be applied
- Timing/ Results Timing To Be Determined: Results will be seen on dyestatcal.com
- <u>Directions:</u> CSUF is located in North Orange County next to the 57 freeway; exit the 57 @ Yorba Linda Blvd. and go West; turn left onto State College Blvd.; immediately turn left into Parking Lot A. or continue south on State College Blvd and turn left on Gymnasium (Gym) Dr and park in the parking structure. **Parking is Free on Saturday**. From Lot A walk directly across West Campus Drive. The track is just South of Titan Stadium, and from the parking structure, walk out the northeast side of the parking structure and head east; turn left on West Campus Drive; the track is located north of the tennis courts.
